Three Rules Clinics will be offered in the Spring via Zoom by Alberta

Golf Referees. Five "Learn to Golf" clinics will be offered free to the public as a means of introducing new players to the game.

The Board has applied for a number of grants to deliver these ambitious programs and to update and launch a new and more interactive website.

Funding will not only enhance the programs that we offer but would allow us to support disadvantaged groups and individuals that face barriers to their participation in the game of golf.
